

### **The Princeton Review SAT Prep course for JCs & Super Campers**

We recognize that it is difficult for busy and stressed students, about to enter their challenging Junior or Senior year in high school, to find time to take SAT prep courses during their academic Junior year. With this in mind, we created a program to help minimize stress levels of JCs and Super campers by enabling SAT test preparation to occur during the summer.

This 12 session course (JCs with us the entire season have the possibility of as many as 17 sessions, with no additional charge for the additional sessions) is available during both JC training sessions. Classes are scheduled during Rest Hours, Lazy Hours, and Campfires, and will not interfere with the JC training schedule or occur during precious Off Duty time. They will begin at the end of this week! **Cost of the course is \$250.**

### **New England College Tour Optional Excursion 2010**

We offer a tremendously successful four-day “whistle stop” New England College tour to inspired JCs that takes them to 12 colleges and universities.

Day #1: Maine: Campus tour visits to: Colby; Bates; and Bowdoin Colleges. At the end of the day, we share dinner with several Harvard, Tufts, and MIT recent alumni who speak to JCs about their college experiences, and then stay at a hotel near Harvard Square.

Day #2: Boston: Campus visits to: Harvard; Tufts; Boston College; Boston University; MIT. Spending the night at a motel near Amherst, Mass.

Day #3: Western Mass. Campus tours of Amherst & Williams Colleges, then driving to New Haven Connecticut. Dinner with recent Yale alumni and spend the night within walking distance of the Yale campus.

Day #4: Morning campus tour of Yale and then driving to Providence Rhode Island for campus visits to Brown & Rhode Island School of Design on the way back to Robin Hood.

A whistle stop tour of New England colleges begins the process of college campus familiarity and helps clarify what style and size of campus an aspiring college student might be interested in spending four years.
